

## Adding a Program to Your Classroom

Once you have successfully created an account, you will be able to start adding programs to your classroom. To do so, you will log in to your account at <http://coa.peachnewmedia.com/store/provider/provider09.php>

Once you have logged in, you will be re-directed to your “**Account Profile**” page. Your “**Account Profile**” page is where you will navigate to in order to View a Program, Submit a Program for Credit, and Edit Your Account Preferences.




